Book bag for babies born 2019-21. Program is funded by The Finnish Cultural Fund and organized by The Finnish Reading Centre. Book bag will be given to 150 000 families.

Books and info materials have been produced by a multiprofessional expert team: authors, illustrators, researchers, librarians, social workers and family health experts.

Why Family health clinics?

The goal is to provide book gift -program to **all families** regardless their social or economic background.

99,4 % of Finnish families visit Family health clinic.

Maternity and child health care centers are **free of charge** and **easy to reach** for clients in every municipality in health care center

Widely used and accepted regardless of social class, **obligatory** to receive financial support


8-9 visits during the normal course of a pregnancy + 10 visits during the first year of an infant's life and once a year after that (1-6 years)

Program timeline



Book bags impact on families reading habits




How has the Book Gift campaign's book bag affected reading in your family? 774 answers

I don't know 1% We have read less than usual 0




What kind of support would you like to support and encourage reading? You can choose one or more answers. 915 answers







Families that first began reading when they received the book bag






Public health nurses are worried about children's language development





47 % of nurses feel that children's language development has declined somewhat or very noticeably in recent years.

42% of nurses said they are concerned about children's language development.

Public health nurses are worried about children's language development

"Children browsing smart devices certainly doesn't promote speech development versus reading."

"Language skills are poorer, and there's less speech production."


"I do many more referrals for speech therapists than I have before."

"Their vocabulary is smaller, and they talk less."

"Speech delays, errors in pronunciation and substitutions, impaired language comprehension."

"In just a few years, I have seen changes in children's speech production for the worse. Their speech is unclear, and phonemes are missing. Day care centers are now more frequently in touch about speech issues."

Nurses felt the book bag was helpful for them: To be able to give such a positive gift in the beginning of the relationship between nurse and family, helps to be a part of families different situations and possible challenges in the future.

Also the themes and content of the stories gives a starting point for different conversations about the problems or challenges families might encounter.

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
